The SRC represents and advocates the interests of UNSW College students, with the aim of enhancing and enriching the student experience across the entire student community.





# SRC Roles & Responsibilities





### 1. Student Agency

The SRC plans and executes events which align with the wider cohort of students' social needs and personal development interests. This involves collaborating with the Student Experience Team.





#### 2. Student Voice

On a quarterly basis, the SRC provides a formal, qualitative feedback channel to UNSW College leaders about student expectations and overall student experience.
