



UNSW College Pre-Masters Course Selection List

All Pre-Masters students will need to undertake a set of compulsory **core courses** as well as **discipline-specific courses** based on their preferred master's degree and/or specialisation. See the list below to guide your course selection.

Compulsory Courses (all students must undertake these courses)

- 1. Innovation & Entrepreneurship (AELS1401)
- 2. Academic Research Literacy Skills (BMGT1402)
- 3. Academic English for Higher Studies (AELS1400) (compulsory for students with an English score of IELTS 6.0 or equivalent)

*Note: These courses do not carry UoC to your master's degree at UNSW.

Discipline-specific Courses

- You must choose courses from the table below depending on your preferred degree and specialisation.
- If students must do Academic English for Higher Studies (AELS1400), students select one course. Otherwise, students select two.
- Discipline-specific core courses (if any) should be prioritised if students can only select one course.

Program Requirements for the Pre-Masters Program

You will only receive the amount of credit (UoC) towards the UNSW master's as specified under the Advanced Standing towards UNSW master's column. Only discipline-specific courses incur UoC.

To progress into the Masters, you must pass all courses (check your Course Outline as to what constitutes a Pass grade).

Other Master's Degree Specialisations

For Master of Engineering (8621) specialisations (Civil Engineering, Environmental Engineering and Mining Engineering) students who successfully complete the Pre-Masters program will be admitted to the master's degree but will not receive recognition of prior learning (advanced standing).
